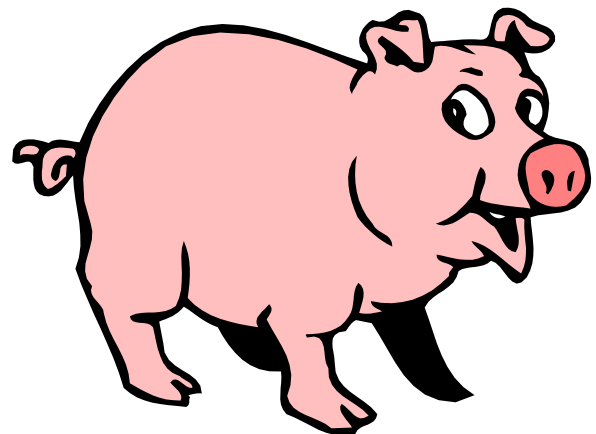

SINGLE MARKET SWINE

- All market swine must be individually owned by the exhibitor for at least 60 consecutive days prior to the opening day of the fair. Proof of ownership must be turned in with entry forms.
- California brand inspection or an out-billing from a sales yard must be made out to the exhibitor, showing 60 consecutive days ownership, or a signed statement that the animal was dropped from the exhibitor's swine and raised by the exhibitor.

REGISTERED PUREBRED BREEDING SWINE

- All breeding swine must be individually owned by the exhibitor for at least 30 consecutive days prior to the opening day of the fair. The management may demand such proof of ownership as it deems necessary in each case.
- Sows, Junior Yearlings or older must have raised a litter of pigs to be eligible for entry. Gilts entered in the market or feeder swine classes may not be entered in the breeding class or vice-versa. Any violation of this rule will exclude the offending exhibitor from competition in all departments of the fair.
- All animals in "registered purebred breeding animal" divisions must be registered and recorded with a United States breed association in the exact name of the exhibitor(owner) as declared on the entry form.
- All breeding swine to be exhibited in California must have a negative official Brucellosis test within 30 days prior to being exhibited.**
- Boars older than 6 months require a negative Brucellosis test within 30 days of entry in CA.**

Group 2/Market Ready Blue Ribbon \$5.00
U.S. No. 1 hogs of average conformation and U.S. No. 2 hogs that are acceptable in leanness, muscularity and production traits.
ELIGIBLE TO SELL

Group 3/Not Market Ready Red Ribbon
No Premium
U.S. No. 3, U.S. No. 4, and Utility grade hogs.
CANNOT SELL

After weighing, market hogs will be divided into weight classes within the specified limitations as desired for convenience in judging. No premium award will be paid on any animal that does not meet the weight requirements of the class.

HOGS WEIGHING OVER 280 POUNDS WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE TO BE SOLD AT AUCTION

Gilts entered in the market hog classes may not be entered in the breeding classes or vice versa.

SINGLE FEEDER SWINE

All feeder swine must be individually owned by the exhibitor for at least 30 consecutive days prior to the opening day of the fair. The management may demand such proof of ownership as it deems necessary in each case.
