## RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING CONCESSIONS AT THE FAIR

1. No concession will be allowed to open until Concessionaire has complied with all preliminary requirements set herein.
2. The Concessionaires and their employees engaged in the operation of concessions where goods to eat or drink are sold, **shall wear suitable clothing, to be kept clean at all times.** All Vendors selling, dispensing or distributing foods, beverages and other articles intended for human consumption shall at all times maintain pure, clean, adequate and wholesome stocks which **must be kept from all contamination and served according to standards as established by state and local agencies. Alcohol is not allowed in booth, unless booth is selling alcohol (needs management approval); nor are employees allowed to consume alcohol while working in booth.**
3. The Concessionaire will conduct his business in a **quiet and orderly manner;** will deposit all rubbish, slop, garbage, tin cans, paper, etc., in receptacles provided by the Association within said concession plot for such purpose, and will **keep the area within and surrounding said concession free from all rubbish and debris.**
4. All buildings, tents, or enclosures erected under the terms of the Concession Agreement shall have the **prior approval of Management and the State Fire Marshal.**
5. **All Concessionaires are subject to daily auditing by Management for the duration of the Fair.** Full cooperation and compliance to audit procedures is required upon request. Concessionaires must provide their own cash registers and be fully operational by noon opening day. The Concessionaire shall post clear and professional signage showing the prices to be charged for all items/services offered for sale to the public under the Concession Agreement; the size of said sign, manner and place of posting subject to approval by Management, and will furnish Management prior to opening day with a list of all sales prices and other charges of any kind whatsoever to be charged by the Concessionaire in said concession space(s).
6. All safety orders of the Division of Industrial Safety, Department of Industrial Relations, must be strictly observed. The Concessionaire will conduct the privileges granted in the Concession Agreement according to all rules and requirements of the State Department of Public Health and local health authorities, and without infringement upon the rights and privileges provided in the Concession Agreement, and that any and all exclusives granted the concessionaire shall not include the Carnival and the Carnival area.
7. Concessionaire acknowledges that Management may enter into exclusive purveyor agreements and Concessionaire agrees to purchase products specified by Management from only approved purveyors.
8. Management will provide necessary janitor service for all aisles, streets, roads and areas used by the public, but the Concessionaire must, at his own expense, **keep his concession space and adjacent areas properly arranged and clean. All concessions must be clean,** all coverings removed, and the concessions **ready for business each day at the time specified by Fair Management.** Management will also provide roving security and will exercise reasonable precaution for the protection of Concessionaires property, but shall assume no responsibility for loss or damage to the property. Small articles easily removed or particularly fragile articles or displays should be put away for safekeeping by Concessionaire after the closing hour each night.
9. **All sound-producing devices** used by the Concessionaire within or outside his concession space must be of such a nature and must be so operated as not to cause annoyance or inconvenience to his patrons or to other Concessionaires or Exhibitors. Management's decision as to the desirability of any such sound-producing devices shall be final and conclusive. Sound-amplification equipment may be installed within or outside any concession only by first obtaining written permission from Mgmt.
10. The Concessionaire agrees that there will be **no games, gambling or any other activities** within the confines of his concession space in which money is used as a prize or premium, and that he will not buy and/or permit "buy backs" for cash, any of his prizes or premiums given away to patrons in connection with his concession. Only straight merchandising methods shall be used and all methods of operation, demonstration, and sale shall be subject to the approval of Management and the local law enforcement officials.
11. The Concessionaire is **entirely responsible for the space allotted to him** and agrees to reimburse Management for any damage to the floor, hall, equipment, or grounds used in connection with the space allotted to the Concessionaire, reasonable wear and tear and damage from causes beyond Concessionaire's control are excepted.
12. All boxes, crates, packing material, and debris used in the concession space and owned by the Concessionaire must be removed from the buildings and grounds by the Concessionaire, at his own expense, not later than two(2) days after the official closing day of the Fair. It is understood that in the event of the Concessionaire's failure to vacate said premises as herein provided, unless permission in writing is first obtained, Management may and is hereby authorized and made the agent of the Concessionaire to remove and store the concession and all other material of any nature whatsoever, at the Concessionaire's risk and expense, and Concessionaire shall reimburse Management for expenses thus incurred.
13. Unless authorized by Management, no Concessionaire will be permitted to dispense, sell or dispose of anywhere on the fairgrounds alcoholic beverages as defined in the Alcoholic Beverage Control Act. **Consumption of alcoholic beverages by any concessionaire or employees while performing duties associated with this contract is strictly forbidden.**
14. Payment for twenty (20) Vendor daily credentials for food concessionaires, sixteen (16) for all others, will be included in the deposit/guarantee. Additional credentials (up to 52) are available to purchase at the discounted rate of \$6.00 each.
15. **ALL BOOTHS AND EXHIBITS MUST BE COMPLETE BY 9:00 P.M. ON WEDNESDAY, JUNE 13, 2012** (day before the Fair opens). Detailed set-up and teardown instructions will follow. Any space not filled reverts to Fair. **NO REFUNDS FOR NO-SHOWS. All vehicles MUST be off Fairgrounds by one (1) hour prior to opening every day, NO EXCEPTIONS. No RV's or stock trucks allowed on any of the Parking Tiers.** RV's & trucks must have appropriate parking pass or will be towed.
16. Someone must be present in your booth during the hours listed below. Concessionaires with unstaffed booths will not be invited to return. **All Commercial & Food Vendor Booths: Noon – 10pm Thurs, Noon – 11pm Fri, 10am-11pm Sat, Noon-10pm Sunday**
17. Concessions may be dismantled Sunday evening **after 10:00 P.M. NO Vehicles allowed on fairgrounds until after 11:00 P.M. or until Public has sufficiently cleared fairgrounds.** All exhibits must be removed by 3:00pm Tuesday, June 19
18. Failure of Management to insist in any one or more instances upon the observance and/or performance of any of these rules and regulations shall not constitute a waiver of any subsequent breach of any such rules and regulations.
