****Motherlode Circuit Qualifying Classes: Must Enter Open Division for points to count and Points will be separated out.***

General Definitions:

Purpose: The purpose of the Versatility Ranch Horse class is to demonstrate the performance, versatility, and conformation of the working ranch horse.

Tack/Equipment: Equipment with silver should not count over a good working outfit. No hoof polish, no braided or banded manes or tail extensions. Trimming inside ears is discouraged, although trimming of a bridle path or excess long hair are allowed. Splint Boots ARE ONLY allowed in cattle classes.

Divisions:

RVH Highpoint: Each contestant must enter ALL classes within their designated division: Open, Limited, Youth, W/J.

Motherlode Circuit: Each contestant may enter any designated class, except cattle classes, to qualify for Motherlode Circuit points, but may not be eligible for RVH Highpoint. Contestant may cross enter to qualify for both points.

Classes:

Ranch Horse Trail: A minimum of six obstacles that one might find out on the ranch. Mandatory Obstacles: Working of a gate, dismount/remount, dragging a log.

Ranch Riding: An individual pattern demonstrating the horses ability to move at working speed, showing changes of gate: walk, trot, and lope, with extension, as designated per arena markers and provided pattern.

Ranch Cutting: Open Division: Cut 2 cattle, one called, one of choice, 2 min time. Limited and Youth: Cut called cow from herd, drive it through markers, 2 min. time.

Working Cow Horse: Open division: reining pattern, call for a single cow, box, move the cow down the fence between the cone and fence and into the pen, hold 10 sec., rope the dummy cow. Limited and Youth: reining pattern, call for a single cow, box the cow and put in the pen, NO roping.

For MOTHERLODE: REINING PATTERN ONLY, NO CATTLE

Ranch Conformation: Horses return to arena in-hand, unsaddled to be shown for soundness and conformation.
